Let's get right to the charts for some concrete numbers and just not another opinion!

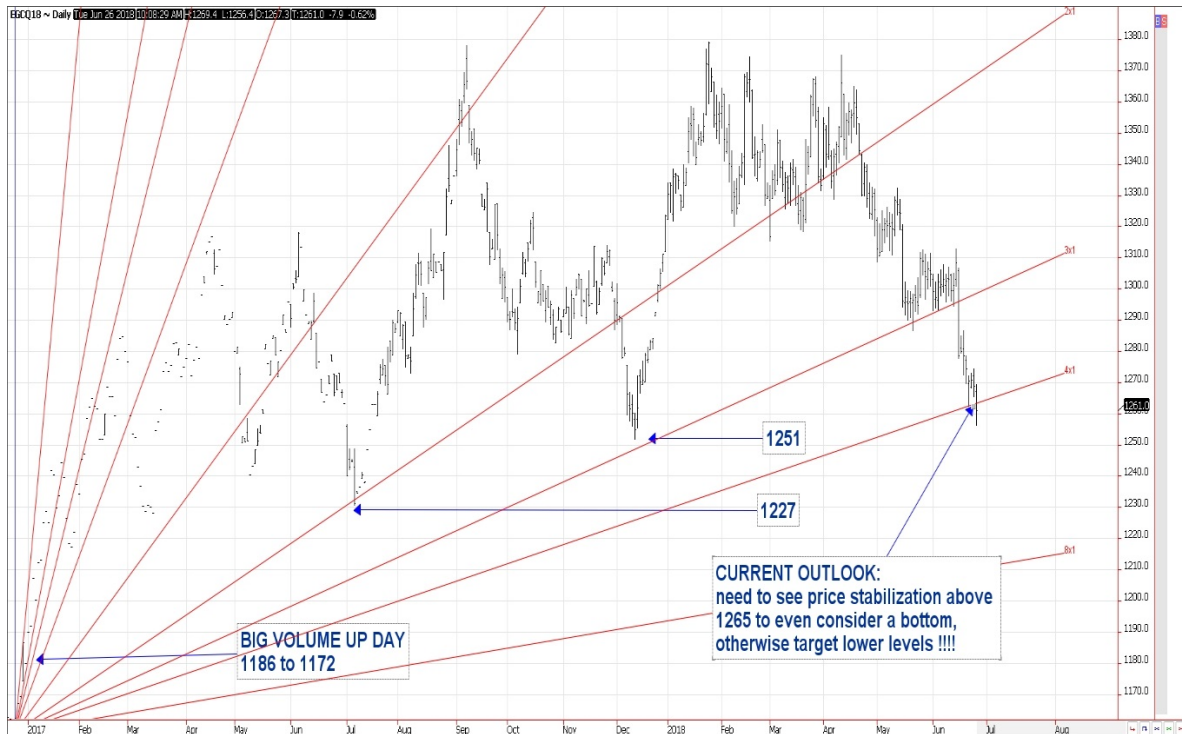
